



Howard County Chamber of Commerce Policy for Member Use of Chamber Logo

The “Proud Member of the Howard County Chamber of Commerce” logo allows others in the business community to recognize Chamber members and their support of and involvement in HCCC.

Members may use the Chamber’s “Proud Member” logo on their company website only. Please contact the Chamber offices at 410-730-4111 or communications@howardchamber.com to obtain specific permission for other uses.

Under no circumstance, however, should the HCCC logo be used as an indication of partnership nor endorsement of a project, event, product, or individual.

Appropriate Logo Usage Agreement

By obtaining the Howard County Chamber of Commerce Proud Member logo, members agree to be bound by the following policies:

- Only the “Proud Member” of the Howard County Chamber of Commerce logo may be used and may not be altered for any reason.
- Members who display the HCCC Proud Member logo on their websites must activate a link from the logo directly to the Chamber at www.howardchamber.com.
- Members may not display the Howard County Chamber of Commerce logo in a manner, size or position that implies sponsorship or endorsement in any form by HCCC.
- These policies do not grant a license or any other right to any Howard County Chamber of Commerce logos or trademarks.

Termination Agreement

Displaying the Chamber logo implies agreement that:

- The member will immediately cease usage of the logo in any form if the organization’s Chamber membership terminates.
- If the member continues to use the logo after the organization’s membership terminates, the organization will be invoiced for a membership renewal.
- The Chamber is entitled to receive from the Court an injunction against further use of the logo without having to post a bond.
- The user agrees to pay the reasonable attorney’s fees of the Chamber if it must go to Court to obtain an injunction and/or to collect the fee or usage after membership has terminated.

The Howard County Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to terminate or modify permission to display its logo at any time. HCCC reserves the right to take action against any use that does not conform to these policies, infringes on any Howard County Chamber of Commerce intellectual property or other right, or violates other applicable law.
